Choir Music: The text of today's **anthem** is one of a number of hymns by the English government official and writer, Joseph Addison (1672-1719). The musical setting (1805) is by the English-born composer and music publisher, John Cole (1774-1855), who flourished after emigrating to Baltimore. The choir's text:

*When all thy mercies, O my God, my rising soul surveys,
Transported with the view, I'm lost in wonder, love, and praise.
Ten thousand precious gifts my daily thanks employ;
Nor is the least a cheerful heart that tastes those gifts with joy.
Through all eternity to thee a joyful song I'll raise:
For, oh, eternity's too short to utter all thy praise.*


